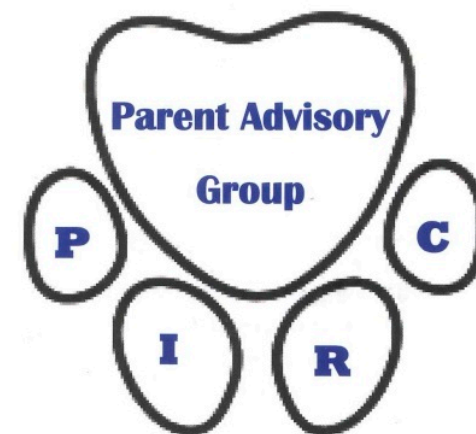

PIRC = Parental Information and Resource Center

The Parental Information and Resource Centers are:

- Federally funded under Title V of No Child Left Behind.
- A national network of 60 statewide PIRCs across the United States.
- Work hand-in-hand with State and Federal Programs to provide information and resources on early childhood through high school parent involvement.

The purpose of the PIRC program is to

- Help implement successful and effective parental involvement policies, programs, and activities that lead to improvements in student academic achievement.
- Strengthen partnerships among parents, teachers, principals, administrators, and other school personnel in meeting the educational needs of children.

The Purpose of the Parent Advisory Group for P.I.R.C. is to enhance and support the educational experience at the Alliance Public Schools, to develop a closer connection between school and home by encouraging parent involvement, and to improve the environment at Alliance Public Schools through both volunteer and financial support.
